This collection consists of a letter dated August 28, 1862 written by a girl named Nell. In the letter, she describes meeting a Civil War soldier named Jess Bollard. Nell describes arranging a meeting with the soldier with the help of her brother, Edd, without their parents' knowledge. She also mentions a dance held in Glenwood (probably South Carolina). The letter is addressed to her unnamed cousin, who may also be a soldier.
