## Biographical/Historical Note

Sarah Ann Chadbourn (d. 1873) of Savannah was the daughter of Captain Jacob Chadbourn. She married John Newton Champion (1797-1845) on December 28, 1831. Champion was born in Massachusetts and moved to Savannah, Georgia to work in the mercantile business with his elder brother. Sarah Ann and John Champion moved from Savannah to Columbus, Ohio in 1835, where he opened a dry goods store under the name Champion and Lathrop. Mary Jane Champion was John's sister. Sarah's brother was Aaron Champion.
