Biographical/Historical Note

G. Davis and Son was a wholesale grocery business operating in Savannah, Georgia, on the corner of Bay Street and Jefferson streets from approximately 1887 until 1893. The Davis family took over the business of Graham and Hubbell in 1886 or 1887. George H. Davis, the son, worked as a clerk. the Savannah City Directories reflect a shift in the business from wholesale groceries in 1887 to hay and grain by 1893.

Scope and Content Note

This collection consists of an itemized bill from G. Davis and Son for groceries sold to Messrs. F.B. Keller and Bro., Savannah, dated October 31, 1887.
