Biographical/Historical Note

George H. Maner (1798-1858) was born in South Carolina. He married Charlotte Mock (1803-1870); Henry C. Maner (b. ca. 1844) was one of their children. Henry Maner lived in Screven County, Georgia and had a son named Henry C. Maner (II). Henry Maner II married Mary Elizabeth Saxon.

Scope and Content Note

This collection consists of a deed of conveyance, 1833, from John Lee to George H. Maner, both of Screven County. The deed is for Lot 535, 18th District, 2nd Sec. in Cherokee County, containing 40 acres; the Lot is a "gold lot," in that it was one of the 40-acre lots sold in lotteries in Cherokee County. During the early 19th century, gold was discovered in Cherokee County, leading to a gold rush on the county. The collection also includes a plat of the Saxon family cemetery lot in Screven County, Georgia, dated 1919.
