Biographical/Historical Note

John C. Rowland (1827-1908) was a cotton factor and commission merchant in Savannah, Georgia. He was also a cotton ginner and (very late in life) he sold insurance.

Scope and Content Note

This collection consists of a warehouse book of J.C. Rowland & Co., 1870-1872, two letters from J.R. Saussy to Rowland regarding payment for foreclosure costs following the decision by the Supreme Court of Georgia, and a receipt from W.P. Carmichael to John C. Rowland for payment of damages and court costs. J.R. Saussy was Rowland's lawyer.
