Biographical/Historical Note

Henry Solomon was a merchant in Augusta, Georgia. Nathan E. Solomon moved to Savannah where he became a merchant.

Scope and Content Note

This collection consists of a letter from Henry Solomon to his brother, Nathan E. Solomon, written from Augusta, Georgia in 1864. Henry writes of conditions at home and gives news of the war, family, and friends. Nathan Solomon was in British Columbia, Canada, at the time. The collection contains two photocopies and one typed copy of the original which remained in the possession of a descendant of the Solomon brothers.
