Biographical/Historical Note

Helena (Helen), John Joachim Jr., and Elizabeth Zubly were the children of David Zubly, Jr., and the grandchildren of the Rev. John J. Zubly. Because of their Loyalist convictions, the family moved from Georgia to the Bahamas after the Revolutionary War. Helena returned to Savannah and married Archibald Smith.

Scope and Content Note

This collection consists of a land grant for a tract on Cat Island in the Bahamas, granted to Helena, John Joachim, Jr., and Elizabeth Zubly. The 1789 grant has a plat attached. The grant came from King George III of Great Britain, as the Bahamas became a British crown colony in 1718.
