Biographical/Historical Note

Nathan C. Monroe was born around 1804 in Fort Edward, New York, but was living in Macon, Georgia during the period of time in which these letters were written.

Scope and Content Note

This collection contains a bound volume of Nathan C. Monroe's business and personal correspondence. Most of the letters are from his relatives who were living in New York, while others concern his mercantile business. A broadside circular for a boarding school, Troy Female Seminary, and a letter from one of Monroe's relatives about the school from 1833 are also included in the volume.
