Biographical/Historical Note

Patrick Houstoun (1742-1785), 6th Baronet, was born in Savannah, the son of Sir Patrick Houstoun and Priscilla (Dunbar) Houstoun. He was commissioned Register of Grants and Receiver of Quit Rents and was a member of the Georgia House of Assembly. He was a Loyalist in the Revolution. He left Georgia for England in 1784 and died there the following year.

Scope and Content Note

This collection consists of a letter from Patrick Houstoun to his brother, John, regarding his suit with Douglass. This letter was originally in the I.K. Tefft Collection of Autographs.
