Hagin, administrator of the estate of William Hagin; note of Joshua W. Hodges to Jephtha Hagan enclosing a check for \$949.62; request of Martin Griner to Jephtha Hagan that he pay to William J.M. Griner the amount that he (Hagins) owes Martin Griner; receipt of Catherine McNell for land purchased from her by Hagins; inquiry of W.P. Hodges to Mr. Hagin as to whether or not he has placed on or two orders with Mr. Cox; receipt of J. Hagins for subscription to the *Federal Union*; subpoena ordering J. Hagin to appear in court to testify in a pending case; purchasing agreement of Aaron Cone and Jephtha Hagins with Cone buying food supplies for the Confederate Army; bill of sale of J. Hagin for the sale of beef cattle to the Confederate Army; notice of administration sale to be held at the resident of the late Jephtha Hagins.
