Andrew Low (1813-1886) was a partner in Low, Taylor and Company of Savannah, Georgia.

This collection consists of a certificate from the United States Congress for an Act of Relief for Andrew Low. Low was acting on behalf of his firm, Low, Taylor and Company. The certificate promises reimbursement for duties paid on merchandise ordered before the duties became law through an act in 1833.
