J. Lawton Whatley was a lawyer in Savannah, Georgia. For many years he was the partner of General Henry R. Jackson under the firm name of Jackson and Whatley. In 1896 he formed a partnership with William G. Woodfin, named Whatley and Woodfin. The firm handled real estate transactions.

This collection contains one account book containing real estate transaction information. Included in the volume are account records for rentals and property improvements.
