## Biographical/Historical Note

Charles Gordon Edwards (1878-1931) was a prominent Savannah lawyer and Congressman. He was the son of Thomas Jefferson Edwards and Annie Conley Edwards. He served in the U.S. House of Representatives a total of eight terms, 1906-1917 and 1924-1931. His career was cut short by his sudden death from a cerebral hemorrhage.

This collection consists of a photograph, taken in Statesboro, Georgia, in 1906 of the delegates at the Convention nominating Charles G. Edwards for his first term in the National Congress, and a certificate of appreciation to Charles G. Edwards from the Lincoln Highway Association of Detroit, Michigan, 1913.
