Biographical/Historical Note

The schooner *Taisita* was a cargo vessel stationed out of New York City. Her masters at varying times were John F. Underhill and Thomas Mayo (1832-1889).

Scope and Content Note

This collection consists of the *Taisita's* logbook from December, 1870 through August, 1872. It contains notes on weather conditions and the everyday activities of the personnel on board the ship. The logbook covers the *Taisita's* voyage from New York to Martinique, St. Kitts, Marquise, Kingston, Savannah, Barico, and other places in the Caribbean.
