Robert Habersham was a planter and merchant in Savannah, Georgia, owning several well-known plantations in the area. His family was heavily involved in the founding, establishment, and growth of the city.

Scope and Content Note

This collection consists of one document, a bill of sale for a slave named Henry. The sale is from John Mallory to Robert Habersham. The transaction occurred in Savannah, Georgia on December 3, 1845. Henry was nineteen years old and was sold for \$550.00 dollars.
