The Bonaventure Chapter of the Daughters of the American Revolution was organized on April 18, 1925 in Savannah, Georgia. The name of Bonaventure was selected in honor of Josiah Tatnall, Jr., Governor of Georgia. Bonaventure Plantation was Tatnall's birthplace, childhood home, home in later life, and his last resting place.
