Biographical/Historical Note

In 1914, the Georgia-Carolina Power Company constructed the Stevens Creek Plant, a 15,000-horsepower generating station on the Savannah River about 8 miles about Augusta, Georgia. This plant provided electricity to Augusta. Effective December 11, 1928, the Georgia Power Company acquired the properties of the Georgia-Carolina Power Company, excepting the Stevens Creek Plant.

Scope and Content Note

This collection consists of a scrapbook of the development of the Savannah River by the Georgia-Carolina Power Company from 1912 through 1914. It includes pictures of the construction of a power station along the Savannah River, most likely the Stevens Creek Plant. All of the photographs are black and white.
