Pulaski County, Georgia, created from a section of Laurens County, was established in 1808. It was named for Casimir Pulaski. Hawkinsville, named for Creek Indian agent Benjamin Hawkins, is the county seat.

Scope and Content Note

This collection consists of marriage records from Pulaski County, Georgia, 1810-1851 and 1840-1856. An index begins after page 230.

These records were microfilmed by the Genealogical Society of Salt Lake City, Utah, and the Georgia Department of Archives and History in 1958.
