## Biographical/Historical Note

The Georgia Volunteers formed from several different companies after the United States Civil War. The First Georgia Militia Regiment, based in Chatham County, Georgia, was organized from the Georgia Volunteers in 1899 and served as a state militia.

## Scope and Content Note

This volume is a ledger of the First Volunteer Regiment of Georgia from 1893 through 1895. The entries were made at Camp Northern in Griffin, Georgia. They provide some basic expenses and supplies for Company A (Republican Blues), Company B (Irish Jasper Greens), Company C (German Volunteers), and Company D (Oglethorpe Light Infantry). The last pages of the ledger contain prices for rations and a list of rations per person.
