R. Jarvis Cooke worked as a student technician in the summer of 1938 at the Fort Pulaski national Monument in Savannah, Georgia. He served as president of Wesley College in Dover, Delaware, 1983-1977.

Scope and Content Note

This collection consists of a microfilm copy of a history of Fort McAllister, entitled, "Sand and Grit: The Story of Fort McAllister, a Confederate Earthwork on the Great Ogeechee River, Genesis Point, Georgia." It was written in 1938 by R. Jervis Cooke, a student technician at Fort Pulaski. This history includes photographs.

The history was microfilmed by the Georgia State Archives in 1958 for the Georgia Historical Commission.
