Biographical/Historical Note

Edward F. Lovell was born in Savannah, Georgia in 1847. He was the son of Edward and Mary A. Lovell of Massachusetts. Edward F. Lovell joined the Confederate Army on July 9, 1864 in Savannah, Georgia. He was a private in Captain John R. Johnson's Company K, 6th Regiment, Georgia Volunteers.

Scope and Content Note

This collection consists of papers relating to the Confederate service of Edward F. Lovell. Included are lists of clothing issued to Lovell, and other documents relating to his service including his medical pass and Oath of Allegiance to the United States. Also included is a photograph of Lovell, ca. 1864-1865.

Item 1: Descriptive list and account of pay and clothing of E.F. Lovell Company K, Symons Regiment, Georgia Volunteers. Includes name, rank, age, physical description, where born, where enlisted, when last paid, list of clothing he was issued at Frampton's Farm, South Carolina, January 2, 1865

Item 2: Letter giving permission for Private Edward F. Lovell, a patient at May Hospital, Augusta, GA, to remain in private quarters and to report to ward B at 8 o'clock daily until further orders. Residence Woodlawn, Augusta, Georgia, February 4, 1865

Item 3: Permission for Private E.F. Lovell, Company K, 6th Regiment, Georgia Volunteers, paroled prisoner, to go home until relieved of parole obligation. By command of Brig. Gen. B.D. Fry. Signed J.B. Dornan, Headquarters, Augusta, Georgia, May 1, 1865

Item 4: Office of Provost Marshal, Savannah, GA, Mr. E.F. Lovell is registered at this office, residence Taylor and Barnard Streets, occupation paroled prisoner of war Johnson's Army. Signed S.M. Chesebro, 1st Lieutenant and assistant Provost Marshal, May 15, 1865

Item 5: Oath of Allegiance to the United States, E.F. Lovell of Chatham County. Witnessed by F. S. Coffin, Lieutenant and Assistant Provost Marshal, Savannah, Georgia, August 17, 1865
Also includes description of E.F. Lovell.

Item 6: Office of Provost Marshal, District of Savannah, permission granted to Edward F. Lovell for the purchase of a fowling piece and ammunition for private use by command of Brevet Major and Provost Marshal J.M. Brannan. Signed M.T. Holbrook, Lieutenant Colonel. 173rd N.Y. V., August 18, 1865

Item 7: Photograph of Edward F. Lovell, circa 1864-1865
