Biographical/Historical Note

The Emory Layne Jarrott genealogical research material documents the genealogy of the Jarrott family and collateral lines. The earliest American ancestor documented in the collection is Seth Ward, 1834, Henrico County, Virginia. The earliest Jarrott ancestor is John Jarrott, 1719, Bath County, North Carolina (later Carteret County, then Onslow County, North Carolina). The earliest Alston ancestor is John Alston, 1684, St. John's Parish, Berkeley County, South Carolina. The earliest Savannah ancestor is Jean Pierre Breton (John Peter Briton), 1738.

Scope and Content Note

This collection contains primarily photocopies of genealogical material compiled by Emory Layne Jarrott from 1970-1999. Material came from the collections of the South Caroliniana Library, the South Carolina Historical Society, the South Carolina Department of Archives and History, the Huguenot Society of South Carolina, the Georgia Historical Society and the personal collection of Emory L. Jarrott.

Included in the collection are copies of excerpts of parish registers for the Episcopal churches in South Carolina and Georgia. A Jarrott family pedigree chart should be used to help identify families or individuals who do not appear as major family headings. The file "multiple lines" contains family information relating to more than one line of the Jarrott family.
