Biographical/Historical Note

Kaye Robinson Kole was born to Samuel Robinson and Kate Holitser Robinson in Savannah, Georgia on 10 December 1935. She married Don Kole in 1955 and had two children, Deborah Kole Shelton and Jeffrey Holitser Kole. Mrs. Kole is a former librarian with a BA in English and a minor in Library Science from Armstrong State College (now Armstrong Atlantic State University). Her current career is as an independent genealogist and researcher. Upon being hired by Abram "Bob" Minis, Jr., she researched and wrote *The Minis Family in Georgia*, published by the Georgia Historical Society in 1992. She also co-wrote *The Jewish Community of Savannah* (Images of America Series, Arcadia Publishing, 2002), *Voices of Savannah: Selections from the Oral History Collection of the Savannah Jewish Archives* (Savannah Jewish Archives, 2004) and was the founder of the Savannah Jewish Archives. She is a member of Congregation Mickve Israel.
